Revolutionärer Weg (Revolutionary Way), the theoretical organ of the Marxist-Leninist Party of Germany, originated in 1969, thirteen years before the party was founded. It is an instrument of the revolutionary and working-class movement for combating revisionism, reformism, and especially modern anticommunism.

Willi Dickhut, head of the *Revolutionärer Weg* editorial team from 1969 to 1991, said about the fundamental importance of this series: “Each issue deals with a certain key problem of our time; all issues together constitute a system for the practical accomplishment of our current tasks. Our theoretical organ does not contain abstract treatises; the individual issues form a dialectical unity of Marxist-Leninist principles and practical experience of communist work gathered over decades. On the basis of Marxism-Leninism, in *Revolutionärer Weg* current changes were analyzed, new insights gained and developed further in terms of theory.”

The system of *Revolutionärer Weg* is unique in the world. In meanwhile 38 issues it has developed Marxism-Leninism further in a comprehensive way: regarding the betrayal of socialism, the analysis of state-monopoly capitalism, the Marxist-Leninist line for the building of a new revolutionary workers' party; on the environmental issue,

on the struggle for the liberation of women, on the work in enterprises and trade unions, on the dialectical method, on the doctrine of the mode of thinking, on political economy, on the struggle against imperialist wars, on the liberation from neocolonial exploitation and oppression, on the strategy and tactics of the preparation of the international socialist revolution, and on revolutionary party building.

Currently, work is in progress on Nos. 39, 40 and 41 of the series, which deal with the crisis of bourgeois ideology and the further development of the doctrine of the mode of thinking.

Starting in 1969 the editorial team was built up and headed by Willi Dickhut. In 1991 Stefan Engel, who was Chairman of the MLPD for 37 years, assumed personal responsibility for the theoretical organ.

A growing number of issues of *Revolutionärer Weg* have been translated into a total of nine languages and today are distributed in 48 countries.

In the first three issues of *Revolutionärer Weg* it was necessary to orient the building of the new revolutionary workers' party to Marxism-Leninism. In No. 1, *Three Programs – Three Documents of Revisionism and Opportunism*, proof first was provided of the revisionist degeneration of the Communist Party of Germany, KPD, and of the necessity for building a new Marxist-Leninist party. No. 2, *The Way to Socialism*, was a reckoning with the revisionist blind alley of “the struggle for fundamental reforms” and the possibility of a “peaceful path to socialism.” Through today these first two books furnish a guide to the struggle against modern revisionism.

Besides revisionism, the young organization had to deal with the antiauthoritarianism that was carried into the Marxist-Leninist movement from the disintegrating petty-bourgeois student movement. To achieve this purpose, No. 3, *Antiauthoritarianism and Working-Class Movement*, was published in 1970. Modern antiauthoritarianism today is one of the chief methods used by the system of the petty-bourgeois mode of thinking to corrode the justified and organized struggle of the youth. This is an important handbook for any rebellious young person!

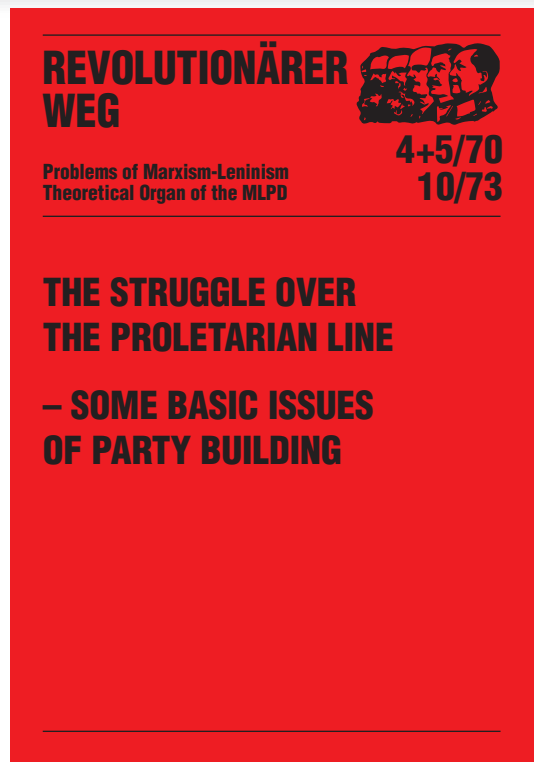

In 1968/1969 the petty-bourgeois student movement collapsed for good.

“Subsequent to the breakdown of the petty-bourgeois student movement in 1968-1969, many intellectuals recognized that, without the striking power of the working class, the capitalist exploitative system cannot be eliminated. What was to be done?”

The KPD/DKP (*Kommunistische Partei Deutschlands/Deutsche Kommunistische Partei* – Communist Party of Germany/German Communist Party) had degenerated into revisionism and wrote the ‘peaceful road to socialism’ on its pink banner. Therefore, the building of a revolutionary workers’ party was an urgent necessity and was justified due to the revisionist betrayal. Groups emerged which set themselves the task of party building on the basis of Marxism-Leninism. These germs of a revolutionary party were invaded by the petty-bourgeois students to ‘take over leadership of everything’ and to carry into them a petty-bourgeois political line. They got into contradiction with the class-conscious workers advocating a proletarian line.” (Foreword to Nos. 4+5)

These two issues of *Revolutionärer Weg* showed how the proletarian road of party building under worker leadership was able to prevail against the petty-bourgeois students’ claim to leadership. They take a position on many basic issues of party building: orientation to the working class, democratic centralism as organizational principle, or the relationship of the Marxist-Leninist party to the revolutionary youth league.

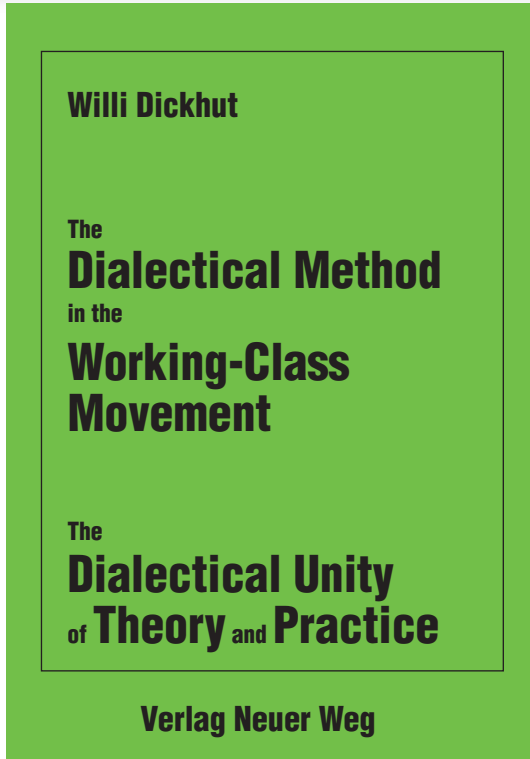

Revolutionärer Weg, No. 6, *The Dialectical Method in the Working-Class Movement*, had the purpose of focusing the party's attention on the independent thinking and acting of its members. The book's topic was not uncontested, however! Leading comrades of KAB/ML (Communist Workers' League/Marxist-Leninists) at first voiced the view to Willi Dickhut, head of the *Revolutionärer Weg* editorial team, that other topics were more important for the practical work of the organization.

Revolutionärer Weg, No. 6, expounds the essence of the dialectical method as established by Marx and Engels and further developed by Lenin, Stalin and Mao Zedong. The book then applies the dialectical method to the development of the societal conditions in the Federal Republic of Germany, in particular to party building. This issue of *Revolutionärer Weg* concretely explains Lenin's "elements of dialectics," especially emphasizing the dialectical unity of theory and practice and the determination of the three stages of the proletarian class struggle in Germany.

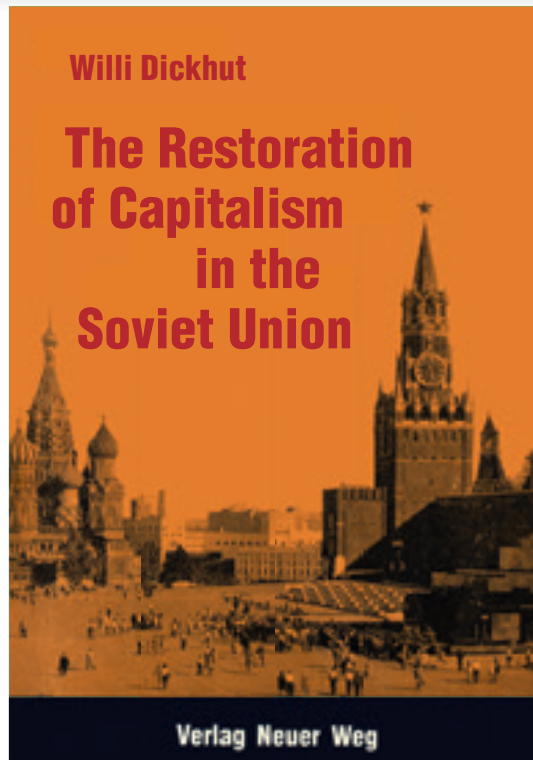

The restoration of capitalism in the Soviet Union since 1956 was a severe defeat for the international Marxist-Leninist and working-class movement. It produced great uncertainty and led to a split in the worldwide communist movement, throwing the worldwide struggle for socialism back considerably.

The book exposed modern revisionism as basis for the system change in terms of world outlook. Not every party recognized the restoration of capitalism because they, too, were influenced by the revisionist ideas of the CPSU and the DKP and followed the road taken by the CPSU. Others, like the Communist Party of China, fundamentally criticized this road. For party building in Germany, but also for the international Marxist-Leninist movement, it was decisive to analyze this betrayal and its causes and process them creatively.

Revolutionärer Weg, No. 7, proves that the Soviet Union was destroyed from within by a new bourgeoisie with a Party membership card in its pockets, that the dictatorship of the proletariat was reversed. The takeover of power by the new bourgeoisie paved the way also for a fundamental change in the economic base. This analysis is carried out in *Revolutionärer Weg*, No. 8. Once the capitalist laws have been introduced, they operate automatically, both inside the country and externally.

Revolutionärer Weg, No. 9, deals with the evolution of the new-type capitalism into social-imperialism and with the further development of modern revisionism by Brezhnev and Deng Xiaoping. This book has been translated into four languages today, including Russian, and disseminated worldwide. It is a fundamental work that has helped many people to understand this development and to take the road of constructing a new party.

In 1972, in a situation with countless splits in the so-called “Marxist-Leninist movement,” the unification of KAB(ML) und KPD/ML(RW) (*Revolutionärer Weg*) into the KABD (*Kommunistischer Arbeiterbund Deutschlands – Communist Workers’ League of Germany*) was a signal of **seminal importance!** Now the task was to comprehensively create the prerequisites for the founding of a Marxist-Leninist party.

- Criticism and self-criticism, the law of development of the party.

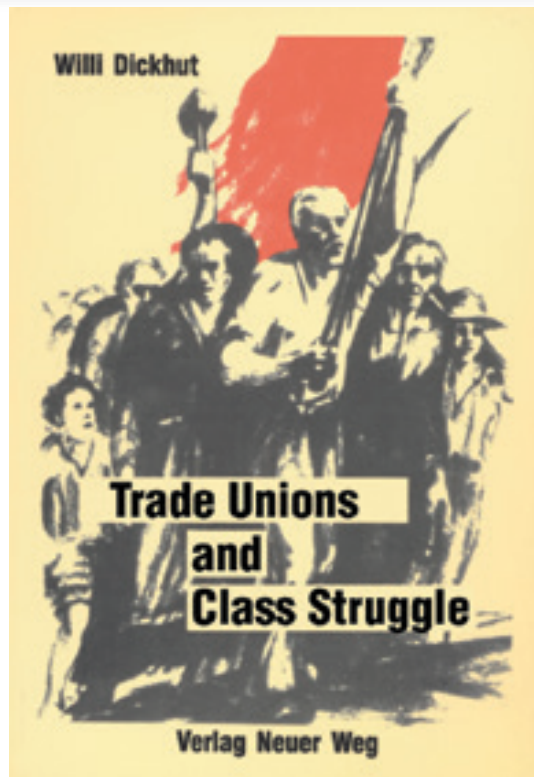

The fundamental orientation of Marxist-Leninist work in enterprises and unions was developed with *Revolutionärer Weg*, Nos. 11/12. It deals with both opportunist and “Left” sectarian mistakes and molding influences in this work, which partly have their origin in the history of the German working-class and communist movement.

The foreword states: “The question of the development and emergence of the working-class offensive does not only depend on the workers’ spontaneous fighting spirit. On the contrary, under today’s conditions, the bourgeois media, the press and, above all, television can purposefully spread uncertainty. Meeting this mood and bringing clarity into the heads requires to recall the historical relations as well as the fundamental experiences of recent years. This book is to make a contribution to it.” (*Revolutionärer Weg*, Nos. 11/12, p. 14)

No. 11 deals with the emergence and development of the unions through today. No. 12 mainly examines the relationship between trade-union struggle and revolutionary class struggle. It provides excellent guidance for the work as a class-militant union member, shop-floor union representative or works council member. The starting point is to understand the struggles of the workers as a school of class struggle.

The economic development of the Federal Republic of Germany (FRG) in 1972/1973 made it clear that the boom period after the Second World War had come to an end and new phenomena were emerging. They had to be analyzed and the necessary conclusions drawn for strategy and tactics.

Revolutionärer Weg, No. 13, proved that one could not speak of a crisis of overproduction – as claimed by bourgeois and petty-bourgeois propaganda – in the FRG in 1973/1974, but that the monopoly bourgeoisie was taking the offensive with the simultaneous application of the measures: “concentration of capital,” “offensive of rationalization” and “capital export.” These were the concrete causes of the emerging mass unemployment. No. 14 proved that these measures inevitably must lead to an economic crisis, however.

The book provides an easily understood introduction to the political economy of Marxism-Leninism and, through its vivid application of Marxism-Leninism to the situation of that period, also an outstanding introduction to political economy in the era of imperialism.

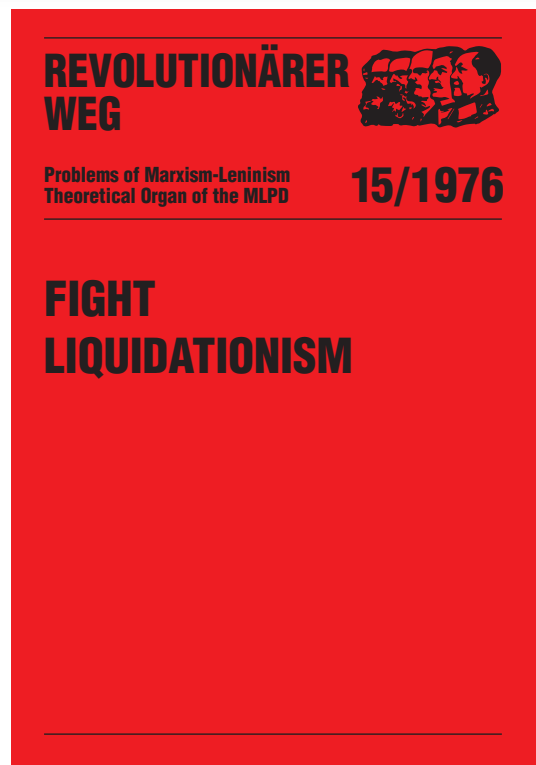

Since the mid-1970s the party increasingly had to come to grips with liquidationism. “With a decrease of the workers’ struggles in 1974 on the background of the fluctuating stagnation in the economy, many petty-bourgeois elements within the working-class movement became insecure and doubted the correctness of the proletarian line, attacked it and thus entered the grounds of liquidationism. ... The altered economic and political situation and its reactionary effects are the most important features of the material basis of current liquidationism.” (*Revolutionärer Weg*, No. 15, p. 12)

Revolutionärer Weg, No. 15, became a milestone in the building of the proletarian party, because for the first time it compiled the manifold manifestations of the petty-bourgeois mode of thinking in the struggle for the building of the new-type Marxist-Leninist party, providing proof that here the main cause of liquidationism had to be sought. With its fundamental orientation to fighting liquidationism it has become an important weapon in the struggle to preserve the proletarian character of the party.

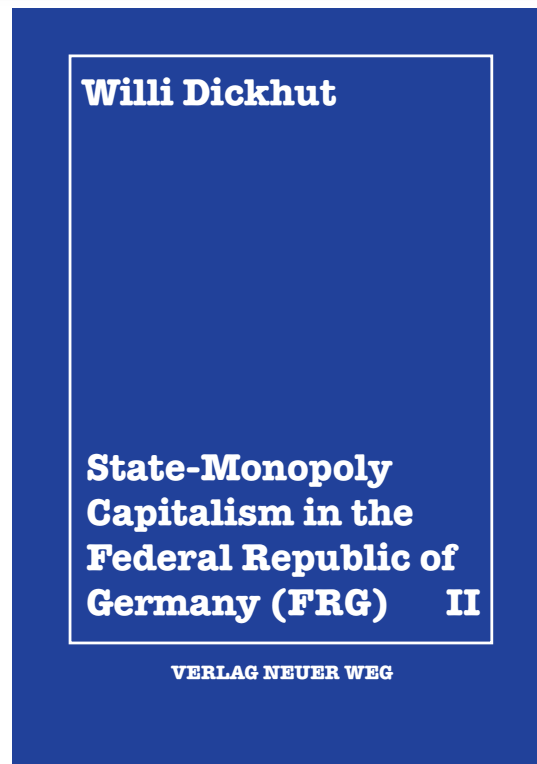

Apart from the many fundamental statements that retain their validity through today, the books also are a lesson in the German history of capitalism.

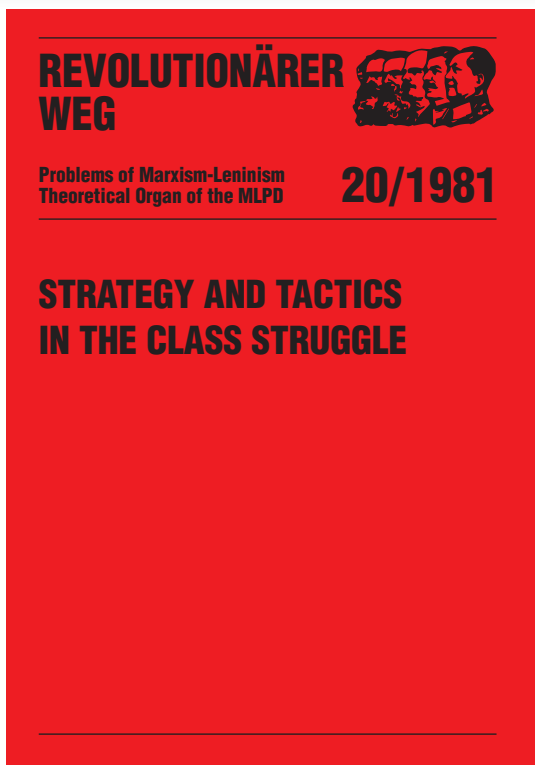

The rapidly changing conditions in the world, the intensification of the contradictions, and the ever greater intervention of the KABD (Communist Workers' League of Germany – predecessor organization of the MLPD), in the manner of a full-fledged party, in the struggles of the working class placed increased demands on the concrete analysis of the concrete situation and the development of strategy and tactics.

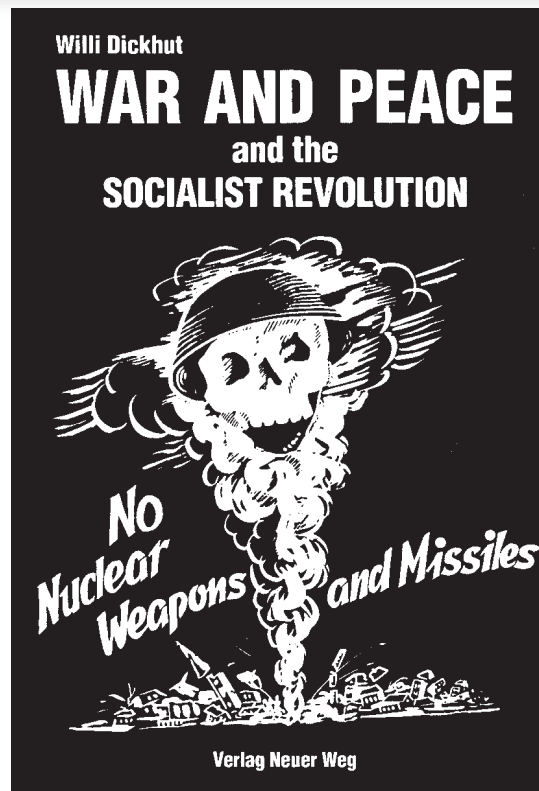

Since 1980, in Europe and in the Federal Republic of Germany a constantly growing peace movement had developed, as this was the period in which the nuclear arms race of the two imperialist superpowers, USA and Soviet Union, reached its pinnacle. The immediate cause was the NATO two-track decision of 1979 aiming at a new nuclear arms buildup with medium-range missiles within striking distance of the Soviet Union. This peace movement had a petty-bourgeois pacifist character. The task of the party was to take up the sincere wish for peace and convince the masses of the need for overthrowing the rule of imperialism as underlying cause of war.

Revolutionärer Weg, No. 22, elaborated the fundamental position of the Marxist-Leninists on the issue of war and peace and, in line with this new development, clarified the character of the Soviet Union as a social-imperialist superpower.

The emergence of a number of new-imperialist countries since the turn of the millennium has intensified the inter-imperialist rivalry tremendously, thus greatly aggravating the danger of a third world war. The book is very important for creating clarity in the struggle against this danger and making a contribution to the building of a strong, militant peace movement.

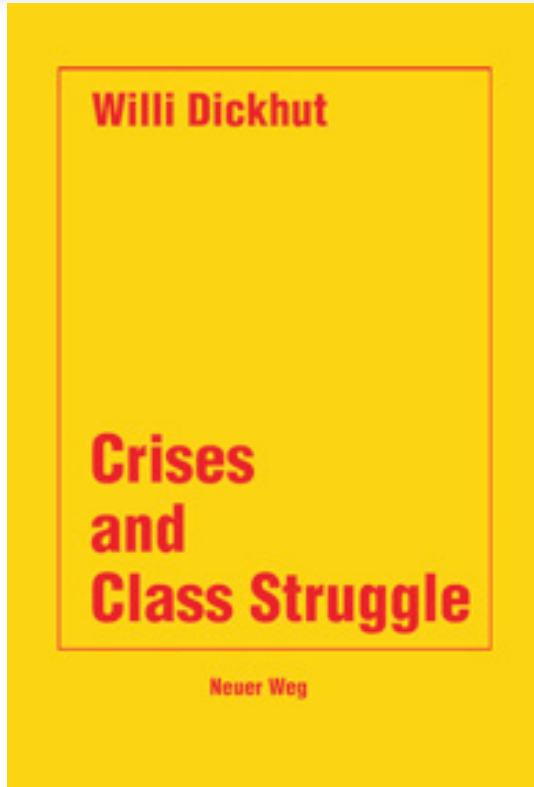

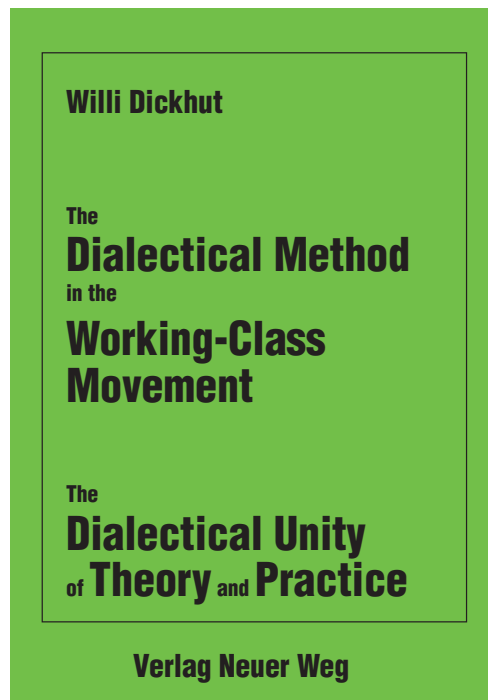

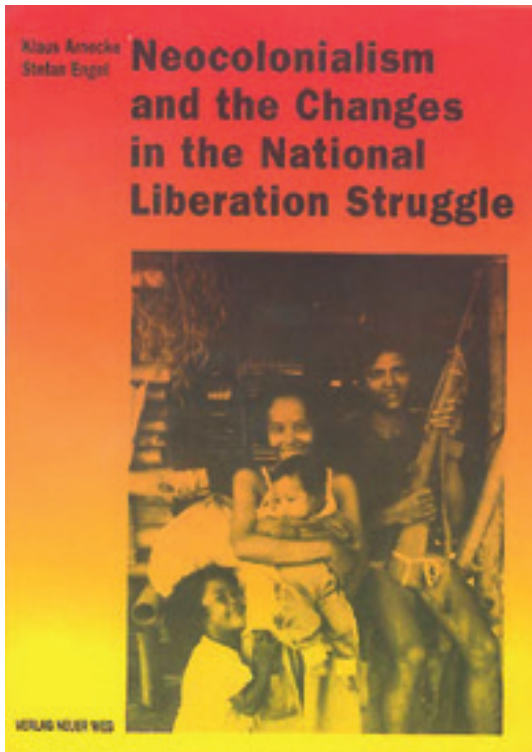

It belongs in the hands of everyone who wants to understand how imperialism developed and how it can be defeated today!

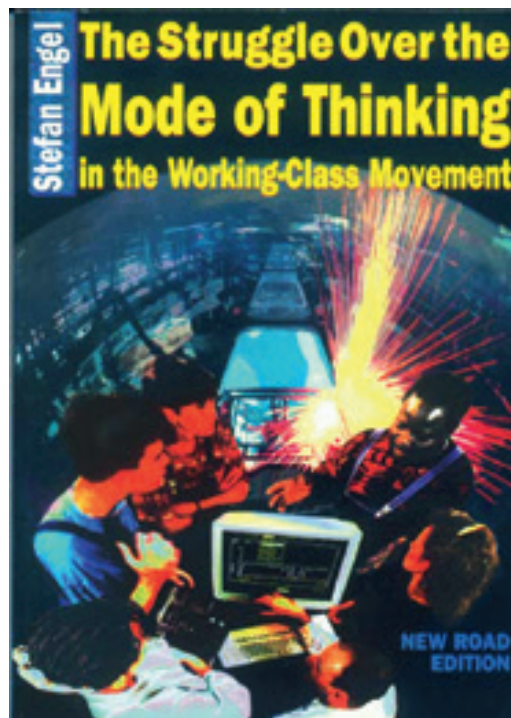

Since the 1990s a militant women's movement has again developed which is closely linked with the working-class movement. The new, manifold experiences and questions coming out of the militant women's movement had to be treated theoretically. The foreword states: "The critique of the bourgeois and petty-bourgeois mode of life of society constitutes a necessary foundation of any struggle purposefully directed towards emancipating women. This critique must not in any way be limited to the specific situation of women, but must uncover, in all its aspects, the entire system of exploitation and oppression in state-monopoly capitalism. The social liberation of the working class and the liberation of women are two facets of the joint struggle for a liberated, socialist society." (*Revolutionärer Weg*, No. 27, p. 9)

Revolutionärer Weg, Nos. 27/28, develops the fundamental positions of the Marxist-Leninists regarding the struggle for the liberation of women. It begins with the historical experience of the women's movement and introduces the reader to the basic positions of Marx, Engels and Lenin. It contends in an all-around way with bourgeois and petty-bourgeois feminism as well as with the bourgeois fiction of the equality of men and women in capitalism. The real liberation of women can be accomplished only in unity with the proletarian class struggle and in socialism. 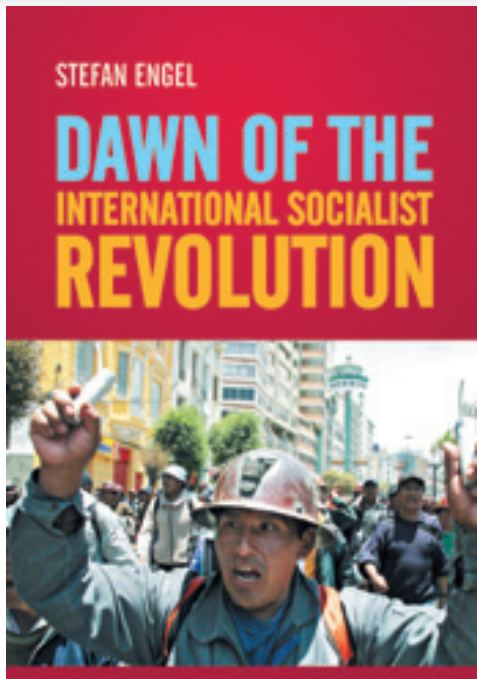

It starts from the Marxist-Leninist analysis of the reorganization of international production, which asserted itself in the capitalist world economy since the beginning of the 1990s, and develops it further – in particular in regard to the international crisis management in the world economic and financial crisis that began in 2008.

In *Revolutionärer Weg*, Nos. 32-34, conclusions are drawn for the strategy and tactics of the preparation of the international proletarian revolution.

Despite all differences between the class struggles in the individual countries, the international proletariat, in alliance with all the oppressed, needs a common reference point: the international socialist revolution. The coordination and revolutionization of the class struggle must unite the progressive, democratic and revolutionary mass movements and organizations into an international force superior to the imperialist world system. The concrete economic, social and political conditions of each country must be considered in the respective proletarian strategy and tactics as much as the general connection with the international revolution. International proletarian strategy and tactics thus appears as an orchestra of different proletarian strategies and tactics of the revolutionary workers' parties in the particular countries.

The book does not claim to formulate a general line, but is intended to stimulate and contribute to the necessary process of intense theoretical discussion and practical cooperation in the international Marxist-Leninist, revolutionary and working-class movement.

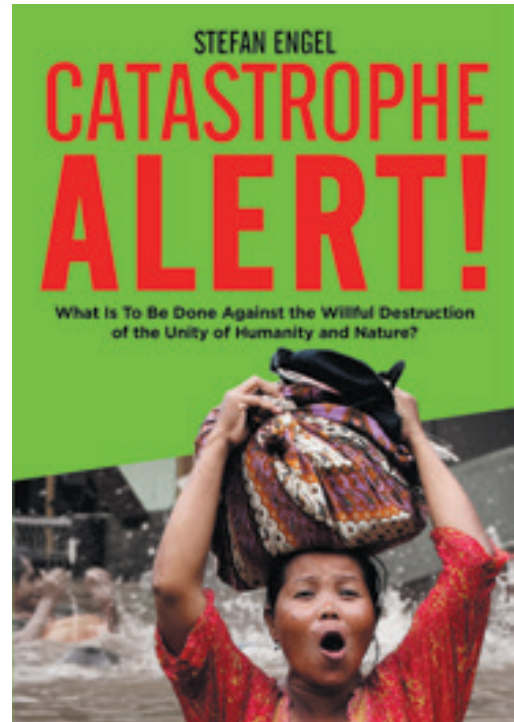
